



Bobby Calves

- Throughout the spring season CCSL will hold Bobby Calf Sales
- All calves arriving must be at least four days old with day zero counted as the day they arrive into the calf shed
- Calves are only to arrive the morning of the sale, NO overnight calves. All calves are to leave the CCSL facilities on the day of the auction
- Calves will be housed for the duration of the sale in weather protected shelters, with clean dry bedding
- Calves will be handled gently with care taken at all times while in the CCSL facilities. NO electric prodders will be used
- It is advised that calves are fed at least half the days ration of colostrum milk no more than two hours before drop off at the Saleyards
- The navel of calves must be dry/withered. No pink/red, raw or fleshy navel's
- All calves must arrive with an ASD form and will leave with an ASD form. They must also have a registered NAIT tag
- Where the transport vehicle is more than 90 centimetres in height from the ground, CCSL will provide a suitable loading and unloading facility. Calves must be able to walk freely onto or off the transport vehicle.
- CCSL has the right to reject any calves on arrival if the animals are not deemed fit for sale
