A day of rain did not dampen the bidding power of the Prime market today at Coalgate, with prices continuing to climb. Prime Steers ranged from \$4.70 - \$5.18 with the Heifers making from \$4.63 - \$5.26, with a spectacular pen of Charolais Heifers at 715kg making \$5.26kg, \$3760 per head. Prime Cows ranged from \$3.46 - \$3.82, and the Bulls made from \$3.82 - \$4.16.

Not a big yarding in the Store Pens today, R2 Cattle made from \$1700 - \$1740, R1 cattle made from \$840 - \$1400.
